Article 12: Once the correction of the vital records has been ordered, it shall be incumbent upon the Office of Vital Records of the respective province to issue a new birth certificate with a reference indicating the location of the certificate prior to its amendment.

Article 13: The original birth certificate that existed prior to the correction of the applicant's sex may be accessed only by persons demonstrating a legitimate interest, or in cases involving legal transactions in which the applicant's genetic usetx innovariably be considered.
